Calling Procedures.

These Calling Procedures have been produced by the committee for the 2014-15 season. These procedures should be read in conjunction with Congleton Pool League Rules Of Play and the Congleton Pool League Constitution.

Actual words spoken are indicated in :- **BOLD & RED.**

(1) **IF THE BLACK BALL IS POTTED ON THE BREAK SHOT :-**

Call :- **“Void Break”**, (Re-rack Balls). Then Call :- **“Same Player to Re-start Frame”**.

(2) **IF THE CUE BALL IS POTTED ON A FOUL BREAK :-**

Call :- **“Foul Break”**, (Re-rack the balls). Then Call :- **“Two Visits, Free Table, First Visit”**.

(a) If a ball(s) are potted on the first visit Then Call :- **“Reds/Yellows in play”**, then wait until they fail to pot a ball Then Call :- **“Second Visit”**.

(b) If no ball(s) are potted on the first visit Then Call :- **“Second Visit” Open Table.**
When a players turn is over Call :- **“Break Over”**.

(3) **IF THE CUE BALL IS POTTED ON A LEGAL BREAK :-**

Call :- **“Foul”**, Hand the cue ball to the oncoming player, Then Call :- **“One Visit, Open Table”**.

(4) **IF A BALL(S) ARE POTTED ON A LEGAL BREAK :-**

Call :- **“BALL(S) POTTED”** and wait for a ball nomination.

(5) **IF NO NOMINATION IS GIVEN :-**

Call :- **“Foul, Two Visits, Free Table, First Visit”**.

(a) If a ball(s) are potted on the first visit Then Call :- **“Reds/Yellows in play”**, then wait until they fail to pot a ball Then Call :- **“Second Visit”**.

(b) If no ball(s) are potted on the first visit Then Call :- **“Second Visit” Open Table.**
When a players turn is over Call :- **“Break Over”**.

(6) **IF IT'S A FOUL BREAK :-**

Call :- **"Foul Break"**, (Re-rack Balls) Then Call :-**"Opponent to Re-start Frame with Two Visits", First Visit, Free Table"**.

(a) If a ball(s) are potted on the first visit Then Call :- **"Reds/Yellows in play"**, then wait until they fail to pot a ball Then Call :- **"Second Visit"**.

(b) If no ball(s) are potted on the first visit Then Call :- **"Second Visit" Open Table**.

When a players turn is over Call :- **"Break Over"**.

(7) **IF IT'S A LEGAL BREAK SHOT, AND ANY BALL(S) ARE LEGALLY POTTED):**

Call :- **"Ball(s) Potted"** Wait for a nomination, If NO nomination is received:- SEE (E).

(8) **IF A PLAYER NOMINATES THE GROUP POTTED :-**

Call :- **"Red/Yellow Balls in Play"**.

(9) **IF A PLAYER NOMINATES THE GROUP NOT POTTED :-**

Call :- **"Red/Yellow Balls Nominated"**.

(10) **IF COLOUR NOMINATED IS THEN POTTED :-**

Call :- **"Red/Yellow Balls in Play"**.

(11) **FAILURE TO POT A NOMINATED COLOUR :-**

Call :- **"Open Table"**.

(12) **BREAK SHOT, FAIR BREAK, NO BALLS POTTED:**

Call :- **"Open Table"**.

(13) **AFTER ANY FOUL WHEN GROUP HAS NOT BEEN ESTABLISHED :-**

Call :- **"Foul, Two Visits, Free Table, First Visit"**.

(14) **FIRST APPROACH AFTER GROUPS ARE ESTABLISHED :-**

On the first time only, that a player is in/takes control of the table, after groups have been established.

Call :- **"Red/Yellow Balls in Play"**.

(15) **LOSS OF FRAME FOULS:-**

Call :- **"Loss of Frame"**. Explain reason.

(16) **TIME FOULS:-**

At 30 seconds,

Call :- “Thirty Seconds”. This must be called on time even if the player appears to be about to stroke the shot.

At Sixty Seconds,

Call :- “Time Foul, Two Visits, Free Table.

(17) **TOUCHING BALL(S) :-**

When the cue ball is in contact with any ball(s)

Call :- “Touching Ball(s)”. Clearly point to ball(s) in contact with cue ball.

(18) **STALEMATE :-**

If the Stalemate Rule is invoked,

Call :- “Stalemate, Re-Rack the Frame, Same Player to Break”, “One Visit”.
